NAWE's mission is to further knowledge, understanding and enjoyment of Creative Writing and to support good practice in its teaching at all levels.

As Subject Association, NAWE promotes Creative Writing as both a distinct discipline and an essential element in education generally. Our membership includes those working in Higher Education, the many freelance writers working in schools and community contexts, and the teachers and other professionals who work with them.

NAWE Networks: for writers in schools - and teachers, university programmes and staff, and a hub for young writers both in and outside formal education.

NAWE Publications: 'getting started' factsheets and briefings, in-depth case studies, 'how did I get here?' features, practical handbooks, and the NAWE magazine, *Writing in Education*, published three times a year.

NAWE Resources: The Writer's Compass e-bulletin with details of all the latest jobs, opportunities and events; archive of writing in education covering 25 years, the UK's only directory of university writing courses, and a Professional Directory of members for use by any prospective employers.

NAWE Events: training days, one-to-one sessions (offering personal assistance in planning a writing career), annual retreat, and the NAWE Conference, the essential UK event for all those involved in the teaching of writing, enabling members to share their experience of teaching writing at all levels.

NAWE Services: public liability insurance, processing of Enhanced Disclosures with the CRB*, professional development advice and input to HE and schools.

* For eligible members, Enhanced Disclosures from the CRB are processed at a fee of £58.

Professional Membership – £65: all individuals working as professional writers in education and the community are encouraged to join at this rate, which includes public liability insurance cover (£10m), processing of CRB checks* and promotion via NAWE's Professional Directory. For schools and other employers, such membership provides an important mark of professional standing. Other benefits include the printed magazine and reduced rates for all NAWE events.


Associate/Student Membership – £20: this rate is for any other writers or colleagues who wish to be involved and keep fully up to date with our work. It provides reduced rates for all NAWE events and publications, and free access to the NAWE magazine and its archive online. Associate members wishing to purchase printed copies may do so at £5 per issue (£15 for a full year).

Institutional Membership – £195: this is primarily for universities and UK writing organizations. It provides full access to resources (including the online magazine) for up to 10 named individuals, together with reduced rates for all events, publications and publicity (such as international promotions), plus one library copy of the printed magazine. Courses and opportunities offered by the institution are given maximum (free) publicity on the NAWE website, and one free advertisement in the magazine. Processing of CRB checks* is also available.

Overseas Membership: individuals based outside the UK can subscribe as Associate Members (£20), adding the printed magazine should they so wish (£20 per annum within Europe, otherwise £30). Likewise, universities outside the UK can subscribe as Institutional Members, with the option of adding printed magazines at the rates as above.

E-Membership - £10: this provides the weekly Writer's Compass e-bulletin with details of all jobs and opportunities for writers generally. The e-bulletin is also sent to members in all other categories.
