About the course

This course will help you to develop your own writing craft, reflect on your practice, and tackle pedagogical challenges presented by teaching creative writing. There will be workshops, seminars, individual tutorials, and talks by authors about their experience of translating good writing practice into great teaching practice.

Following the course, the Centre for New Writing will establish and host a network and resource bank for continuing support throughout the teaching year.

Venue

The venue for the evening meal and overnight accommodation is College Court, the University of Leicester's conference centre, situated beside the Attenborough Arboretum, which gives it the feel of a countryside retreat.
