About the course:

The course will help you to develop your own writing craft, reflect on your practice and tackle pedagogical challenges presented by teaching creative writing. There will be workshops, seminars and individual tutorials, and talks by authors about their experience of translating good writing practice into great teaching practice. You will be given access to the Resource Bank for continued support throughout the teaching year.

Venue:

The course will take place on the University of Leicester main campus (LE1 7RH) approximately half a mile from Leicester train station. The dinner and overnight accommodation is at the University's new conference centre College Court (LE2 3TQ) approximately one mile from the campus.

Fees:

- £375 standard non-residential
- £445 residential (inc overnight bed & breakfast on 6 July)
- £195 self-employed or hourly paid (non-residential)

Course tutors:

Designed and delivered by the University's Centre for New Writing, the course will be taught by experienced writers and A-level exam board representatives. There will be plenty of time to get to know your tutors and each other. The acclaimed poet Daljit Nagra will give a reading and answer your questions at the evening dinner on Monday 6 July. Daljit is a poet and teacher whose works include *Look We Have Coming to Dover!*
